Mary Kom: A Champion's Journey

Chungneijang Mary Kom Hmangte, popularly known as Mary Kom, is from a humble family in rural Manipur, northeast India, with balanced school, farm work, and a love for sports like football, volleyball, and athletics. Inspired by Dingko Singh, a Manipuri boxing champion, Mary secretly pursued boxing despite her father's initial concerns. His support grew after seeing her passion in a newspaper photo, and she quickly returned to training after marriage and the birth of her first child. Her unwavering dedication brought a glittering career with numerous accolades, including silver at the 2008 AIBA Women's World Boxing Championships, gold at the Asian Indoor Games, and bronze at the 2012 Olympics. Notably, Mary is the only female boxer with six World Amateur Boxina Championship titles and medals across seven championships, amassing over 20 medals in two decades and earning the title "Magnificent Mary." She also established a sports club in Manipur to support young boxers. Appointed to the Rajya Sabha in 2016, Mary is a PETA advocate, emphasizing compassion for animals: "One of the best ways to knock out cruelty is to teach compassion to young people." Her journey reminds us of the power of resilience. Despite her achievements, she remains grounded, honoring her roots in Manipur's farming community. Mary's story shows us that with determination, dreams can truly come to life.
